Clonbrin Bog Trail

5km Looped Trail • Clonbrin Shield Discovery Site



i Clonbrin Bog Trail is a 5km looped trail from Abbeyshrule Harbour past Clonbrin Bog and back to the village. It is part of the longer National Famine Way – a 165km walking trail from the National Famine Museum in Strokestown, Co. Roscommon, and continues through six counties to EPIC. The Irish Emigration Museum in Dublin's Docks, and follows part of the Royal Canal Greenway. The Clonbrin Bog Trail begins in the picturesque village of Abbeyshrule, continues along the Royal Canal Greenway across Scally's Bridge and Whitworth Aqueduct, to Clonbrin Bog and the discovery site of the Clonbrin Shield. It continues to meet the 12th Century Cistercian Abbey and historical burial grounds and crosses the River Inny back to the harbour.

Clonbrin Bog Trail: 5km, 50mins/hr.
